

PROXY FORM

Under Section 34 of the Sunbury U3A Constitution, a Proxy can be appointed by a financial member of Sunbury U3A to vote and speak on their behalf at a general meeting, other than at a disciplinary appeal meeting.

- The appointment of a proxy must be in writing and signed by the member making the appointment.
- The member appointing the proxy may vote on behalf of the member in any matter as they see fit.
- A form appointing a proxy must be given to the Chairperson of the meeting before or at the commencement of the meeting.
- A form appointing a proxy sent by post or electronically must be received by the Association no later than 24 hours (16th August 2023) before the commencement of the meeting.
